



# Language Inputs on a Chromebook

(Note: Different Versions of Chrome OS May Have Different Interfaces)

<b>Add a Language</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Click the icons in the bottom-right corner of the screen</li> <li>2. Click  (<b>US or other language keyboard</b>)</li> <li>3. Click the <b>Gear</b> icon  in the upper-right, pull-up window</li> <li>4. Click <b>Language</b>, and then <b>Add Languages</b></li> <li>5. Find a desired language, check the box next to it, and click <b>ADD</b></li> </ol>
<b>Enable a Language Input</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>6. Click <b>Input method</b> (See 1-3 above if you closed after Step 5)</li> <li>7. Click <b>Manage input methods</b></li> <li>8. Find and check the box for a desired language</li> <li>9. Close the dialog window</li> </ol>
<b>View or Switch Inputs</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>10. Click the downward triangle at Step 2 and select a language input</li> </ol> <p><b>TIP:</b> You can also switch your language by pressing <b>Ctrl + Shift + Space</b> until you see the language you want. To switch back or between last two used languages, press <b>Ctrl + Space</b>.</p>
